



KEY PEOPLE, PLACES & PERIODS

Boudicca Saxon Queen who fought back against the Romans.

Julius Caesar 2 Famous Roman leader who attempted to invade Britain.

Colchester The Roman capital until it was destroyed under Boudicca's rebellion.

Emperor First Roman emperor to successfully invade Claudius Britain.

Cleopatra 5 Wife of Julius Caesar, late Egyptian ruler

Hadrian's Wall 6 A wall built by the Roman Emperor to stop Scottish rebels from attacking.

Londinium 7 The Roman name for London

Paulinus 8 Roman governor (ruler) of Britain in AD60.

A city which spawned an Empire which stretched across Europe and North Africa.
