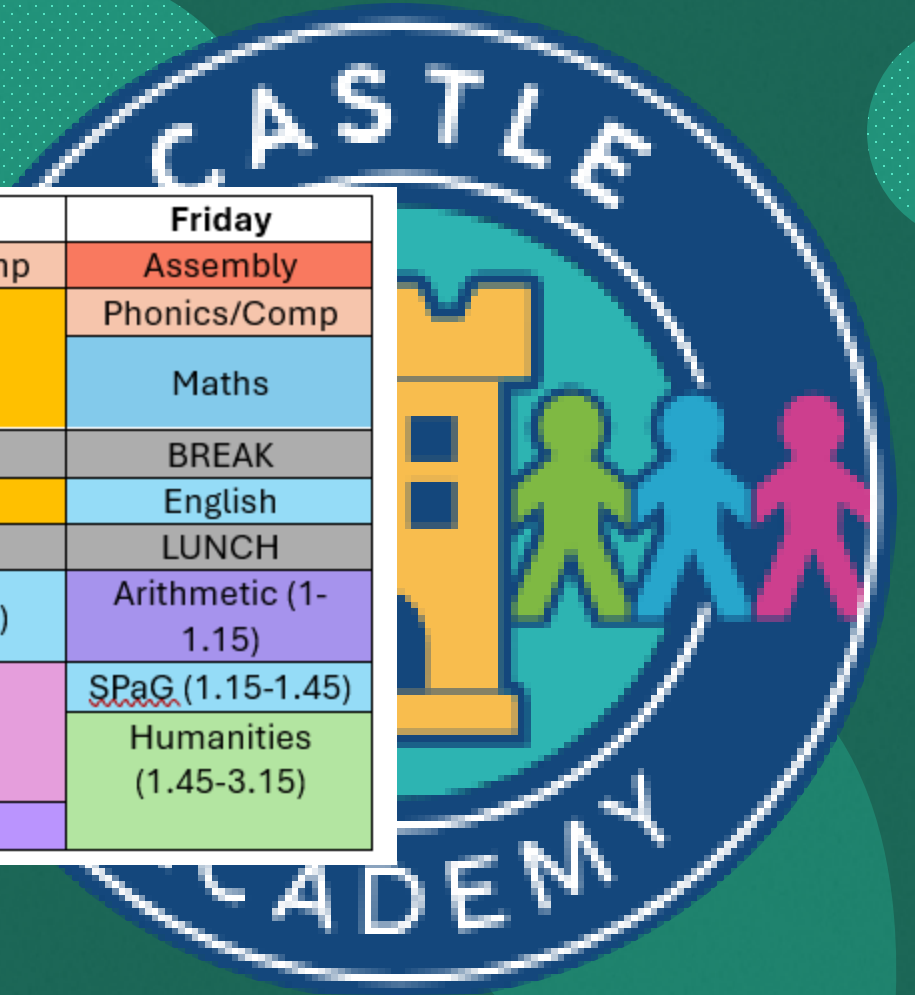

Behaviour and Expectations

- 1,2,3 Magic – Promoting positive behaviour
- House points, proud cloud, class reward tracks, privileges
- Warnings “that is 1, that is 2...”
“That is 3” = consequence.
- Consequences are personal to the individual child. E.g. missing a part of a playtime or choosing time.



Behaviour and Expectations

Immediate 3 (Unacceptable behaviour)

- Behaviour is recorded and monitored
- Parents contacted and a senior member of staff notified.
- A consequence is given. Immediate 3 letter sent home. Please discuss this with your child.
- The reply form must be returned to school.



Reading

Reading is vital

Reading activities will take place daily, so please ensure reading records and books are in everyday

Children must have their reading records signed by an adult (at least 3 times per week)

Reading is monitored



Homework

- daily reading
- weekly times tables
- maths recall sheets
- handwriting activity- joining letters
- English basic skills activity, including spellings and comprehension activity



Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS)

All children in Year 4 will complete a Multiplication Table Check in the summer.

TTRS has been shown to support the learning and recall of the 2-12 times tables.

This is done through various game-style activities which help to mimic the MTC.

Children are expected to spend time completing set tasks every week as part of their homework.

Logins are to be found in your child's reading record

TTRS can be used on browser or downloaded as an app.
