# TIMINGS

School timings will stay the same as last year.

8.40am - Classroom door opens

8.45am - Classroom door closes, register starts.

If you arrive after 8.55am, your child is late. It is very important to arrive on time so children do not miss learning time.



# TIMINGS

School timings will stay the same as last year.

3.15pm – Classroom door opens.

3.20pm – Classroom door closes.

If your child has not been collected by 3.20pm, they will be taken down to the front office and will need to be collected from there.

# FOOD AND DRINK

Lunch: Children can have either a packed lunch or a school lunch. School lunches must be ordered on the Arbor app.

Snack: Children are provided with a free healthy snack at break time.

Drinks: We are a water-only school. Children should bring in a bottle every day with water. This can be refilled at school.

**We are a nut-free school, do not send any food containing nuts.**



# BEHAVIOUR POLICY

At Castle, we use the 1-2-3 behaviour system. If a child is not meeting expectations, we give them a warning – this is a ‘one’. If they continue the behaviour, this is a ‘two’. If they continue after two warnings, this is a ‘three’ and they receive a consequence. This will vary depending on the behaviour and consequences are agreed with children that it is a fair consequence.



# BEHAVIOUR POLICY

An immediate 3 means the behaviour required an immediate consequence without warnings. If a child receives an immediate 3, they will spend a portion of their lunch outside Mr Lugg's office as a consequence. As guardians, you will be informed by a teacher at the end of the day and given a letter to sign. The '3' just refers to our 1-2-3 behaviour policy.





# HOME LEARNING

Home learning is a very important part of your child's school experience.

Children should be reading at home every day, and you must sign their reading record when you read with them.

This will be checked daily.

Children will have homework books sent home each week with homework to complete. This should be completed independently as much as possible. If there are any confusions about homework tasks, please feel free to ask me at the door.

Homework needs to be in on **Thursday** and is handed out on **Friday**.



# HOME LEARNING

In addition to reading and homework, children have a NumBots login to practice their addition and subtraction. They will have tasks set each week to support their learning.



# COMMUNICATION

# IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- PE is on Thursday, children come in wearing PE kit.
- Uniform **must** be labelled.
- Reading, homework and NumBots is **compulsory**.
- We are a nut-free school.
- Phones cannot be used on school site.
- Drop-off is 8.40am, pick-up is 3.15pm
