# School behaviour strategy for promoting positive behaviour.

Warnings "that is 1, that is 2..."

- ❑ "That is 3" = consequence.
- ❑ Consequences are personal to the individual child. E.g. missing a part of a playtime or choosing time.
  
- ❑ **Immediate 3 (Unacceptable behaviour)**
- ❑ Behaviour is recorded and monitored
- ❑ Parents contacted and a senior member of staff notified.
- ❑ A consequence is given. Immediate 3 letter sent home. Please discuss this with your child. The reply form must be returned to school.

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# Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS)

- All children in Year 4 will complete a Multiplication Table Check in the summer.
- TTRS has been shown to support the learning and recall of the 2-12 times tables.
- This is done through various game-style activities which help to mimic the MTC.
- Children are expected to spend time completing set tasks every week as part of their homework.
- Logins are to be found in your child's reading record
- TTRS can be used on browser or downloaded as an app.
