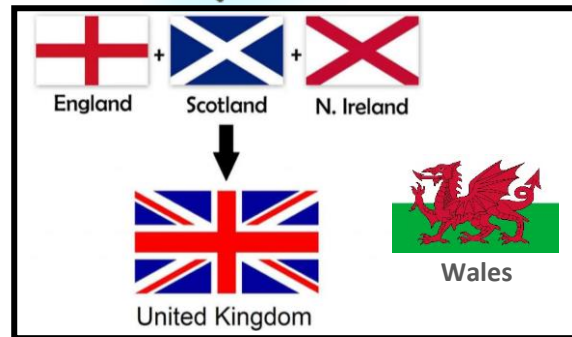

KEY VOCABULARY

1	Country	A country is land that is controlled by a single government.
2	Capital City	Is the city where the government of a country functions.
3	City	A place in which people live and work that is larger than a town.
4	Human features	Are things that have been built by people.
5	Physical features	Are natural. They would be here even if there were no people around.
6	Sea	A body of salt water not as large as an ocean and often nearly surrounded by land.
7	Ocean	A huge body of salt water. Oceans cover nearly 71% of Earth's surface.
8	Island	Areas of land that are not connected to a continent and are surrounded by water.
9	Landmark	An object or a feature of a landscape or town that has importance or makes a place easily recognisable.
10	Mountain	A landform that rises high above its surroundings, taller than a hill.
11	Countryside	Are rural areas which are not towns or cities, they are often farming or agricultural areas.
12	Weather	Is what the sky and the air outside are like, such as cold and cloudy.

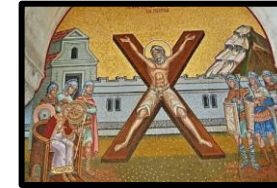
